The regulations/guidelines specified herein are applicable for admission of candidates to various Diploma, Under Graduate and Post Graduate programs offered by *Angadi Institute of Technology and Management, Belagavi*, for the academic year 2023-24. These are subject to change according to the orders of the DTE, KEA, COMEDK, AICTE, the State Government of Karnataka.

1. PREAMBLE:

This policy aims at providing procedures and guidelines with respect to the Admission process of Angadi Institute of Technology and Management, Belagavi. The Policy framework refers to the admission to the various Diploma, Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Research Programs offered by the Institution. This framework comprises of basic rules with respect to admissions and any modification in this policy should be brought by an amendment with due approval from the Board of Management. This policy framework supersedes the earlier policy framework and comes into practice after the due approval from the Board of Management.

2. ABOUT AITM ADMISSION CELL

Angadi Institute of Technology & Management (AITM) stands as a symbol of educational excellence, inspiring students to reach new heights, encouraging them to embrace the endless possibilities that engineering has to offer and providing a holistic learning environment that nurtures students' overall development.

Under the wing of the Suresh Angadi Education Foundation (SAEF), the AITM was established in the year 2009. AITM offers seven undergraduate Bachelor of Engineering (B.E) courses in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science, Robotics & Automation Engineering, Civil Engineering, Computer Science and Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering. AITM offers postgraduate courses in Master of Business Administration (MBA) specialization in Marketing, Finance and Human Resource Management, Master of Computer Application (MCA), Master of Technology (MTech.) in Production Engineering and System Technology (Mechanical Engineering) and Waste Management, Health & Safety Engineering (Civil Engineering). AITM also offers Diploma courses in Civil Engineering, Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. Six departments have been recognized by VTU as Ph.D. research centers to conduct research work.

The constitution of admission committee contain, Head of the Institute, Management Representative, Finance officer, administrative staff, Admission Coordinator and Head of the department.

3. VISION AND MISSION OF THE INSTITUTE

4.1.2 ELIGIBILITY (B.E.)

- A candidate who has passed 10 + 2 pattern of examination (equivalent to the two year Pre University in Karnataka) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with Chemistry/ Biotechnology/ Biology/ Computer Science/ Electronics as optional subjects in the qualifying examination is eligible to pursue an undergraduate degree in engineering at MSRIT.
- The eligibility for admission is 45% in case of General Category and 40% marks in the qualifying examination in case of SC/ST, Category-1 and OBC Category candidates. The marks obtained by the candidate in Biotechnology/ Biology/ Computer Science/ Electronics in the qualifying examination will be considered in the place of Chemistry in case the marks obtained in Chemistry is less for the required aggregate percentage for the purpose of determination of eligibility (and not for the purpose of determination of rank, in respect of engineering/technology courses).
- Entrance Exam: Candidate should have qualifying rank in either CET or COMEDK entrance test.

4.1.3 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR NRIS/FQ/PIO UNDER SUPERNUMERARY QUOTA TO B.E., UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMS ONLY

- 10 + 2 pattern of education which is equivalent to Pre-university of Karnataka, India with Physics, Mathematics along with Chemistry / Biotechnology / Computer Science / Electronics / Biology as optional with English as one of the language of study and obtained a minimum 50% of marks in the optional subjects (as per VTU eligibility criteria for the year 2019-20).
- NRIs- Children of Indian Workers in the Gulf Countries are eligible for NRI Quota (as per The Gazette of India - 2004)
- Foreign Nationals – Citizens of all countries other than India. (as per The Gazette of India - 2004)
- PIO – Persons who are citizens of other countries (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) who at any time held an Indian Passport, or who or either of his parents or any of his grand parents was a citizen of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India (as per The Gazette of India - 2004)

4.2.2 MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)

- We offer a 2-year MBA program, open to candidates who have a 3-year bachelor's degree from a recognized university with not less than 50% of the marks in aggregate of all the years of the degree examination and 45% in case of candidates from Karnataka belonging to SC/ST and Category-1. [Entrance Exam: KMAT / CMAT / MAT/ PGCET – any one mandatory]

4.2.3 MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATION (MCA)

- We offer a 2-year MCA program, open to candidates who have passed a 3-year bachelor's degree from a recognized university with not less than 50% of the marks in aggregate of all the years of the degree examination with Mathematics/ Statistics/ Computer Science/ Computer Programming/ Computer Applications/ Business Mathematics/ Business Statistics as one of the optional subjects/ electives at degree level. In case of candidates from Karnataka belonging to SC/ST and Category-1 the minimum aggregate is 45%. [Entrance Exam: KMAT or PGCET – any one mandatory]

4.2.4 MASTER OF TECHNOLOGY (M. TECH)

- **Civil Engineering:** Waste Water Management, Health and Safety Engineering
- **Mechanical Engineering:** Production Engineering and System Technology (PEST)

The M. Tech programs for which candidates with a B.E/ B. Tech degree in the relevant discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate are eligible. The minimum aggregate marks required are 45% in case of candidates from Karnataka belonging to SC/ST & Category-1.

For Management quota seats, Angadi Institute of Technology and Management, Belagavi invites applications from candidates who meet the basic requirements for admission, which were listed above. Based on personal counseling, these seats are allocated to the most qualified applicants who applied.

6. FEES STRUCTURE

Fee as fixed by the Government of Karnataka, KEA/ COMED- K for the academic year 2023-24 is as mentioned below:

- Fees for BE Students admitted through CET- Rs 104,265/- + Skill lab fees-10,000/- per year
- Fees for BE Students admitted through CET (SNQ) - Rs 31,360/- + Skill lab fees-10,000/- per year
- Fees for BE Students admitted through COMED-K- Rs 191,936/- + Skill lab fees-10,000/- per year

ADMISSION POLICY

Angadi Institute of Technology and Management, Belagavi is approved by All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and Directorate of Technical Education (Karnataka State), it is affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi, Karnataka. Entire

admission process for First Year Engineering and Direct Second Year Engineering is carried out through Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA, Government of Karnataka) and COMEDK- Consortium of Medical, Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka. The institute strictly follows rules laid down by the DTE, KEA and COMEDK.

7.1 ADMISSION NOTIFICATION:

Every year, the KEA publishes the information regarding admission process on its Website (kea.kar.nic.in) and in admission brochure.

7.2 SEAT DISTRIBUTION

FIRST YEAR ENGINEERING (B.E)

- 45% of total seats are filled through centralized admission process controlled by the KEA.
 - 30% Seats are filled through COMED-K, which is an government approved unit of private engineering colleges.
 - 25% seats are filled at institute level, as per the guideline given by the DTE, Karnataka.
 - 5% additional seats against the approved intake of each UG branch as Supernumerary quota (SNQ) by KEA.
-
- ❖ When assigning seats through the CAP online method, reservations for different groups in Karnataka State are taken into account.
 - ❖ An additional seat is allocated in each course, exclusively for Jammu and Kashmir migrant students, in Non-Autonomous institutes, in addition to the officially approved intake.
 - ❖ Provisions are made to allocate a specific number of seats for nominees from States and Union Territories that have limited access to technical education facilities.
 - ❖ The selection of candidates for the Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS), which is designed for students from Jammu and Kashmir, is based on the admission criteria established by the Government of India. The allocation of Supernumerary seats in AICTE approved colleges to North Eastern States and UT's that lack sufficient technical education infrastructure would be carried out by competent authorities designated by the Central Government, in accordance with the specified eligibility criteria.

DIRECT SECOND YEAR ENGINEERING

All seats are filled through KEA controlled by the DTE, Karnataka. Reservations applicable for various categories belonging to Karnataka State are considered while allotting the seats through online system of KEA

LATERAL ENTRY SEATS

- **10%** of Sanctioned Intake, which will be over and above, Supernumerary to the approved Intake.
- **Vacant Seats:** The seats, within the sanctioned intake, which remain vacant during previous year.

7.3 SEAT ALLOTMENT:

- The merit list in all categories is prepared by the DTE on the basis of applications received and score secured by the candidate in the qualifying examination.
- Allotment of seats is based on state and category merit number generated by the DTE and preferences given by candidate.
- For admission to the Direct Second Year of Engineering for all programmes through KEA, the merit list in all categories is prepared by the DTE on the basis of applications received and score secured by the candidate in the qualifying diploma examination.
- Allotment of seats is based on state and category merit number generated by the DTE and preferences given by candidate.
- The final fee approved and published by the Fee Regulating Authority for that year shall be the fee payable by the candidate for that course for that academic year.

7.4 CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

- The candidate should have taken admission by paying necessary tuition fees and should have submitted original certificates before he / she applies for cancellation. In case the candidate fails to submit any of the original documents, within the allowed time limit, the admission shall be treated as cancelled.
- The candidate shall apply online for cancellation and submit duly signed copy of system generated application for cancellation of admission to the institution. Once the candidate submits the online request for cancellation of admission, his / her admission shall be treated as cancelled. Candidates admitted through institute level(Management) quota can cancel their admission by applying in prescribed format to the Principal of the institute.

- The candidate shall not be entitled for any refund of fees except the security deposit and caution money deposit if the candidate effects the online cancellation after 5:00 pm of the cut-off date prescribed by the competent authority.

7.5 UPLOADING OF LIST OF ADMITTED CANDIDATES ON KEA WEBSITE:

- The Candidate shall report to the institution finally allotted to him and confirm his admission in institution as per the schedule. The Institute shall verify the required documents and upload the admission of the candidates in the online system through Institute Login immediately and shall issue a system-generated receipt of confirmation of admission to the candidate.
- The Principal of the institute is required to update the list of all admitted candidates of KEA and against KEA vacancy seats immediately as per the schedule of admission on the KEA website through their institute login.

7.6 UPLOADING OF LIST OF ADMITTED CANDIDATES ON VTU PORTAL FOR FINAL APPROVAL

- The admission approval of the students will be carried out online through VTU admission portal, software application is available at the URL - <https://admissions.vtu.ac.in>. The information of students admitted through KEA/COMEDK/KRLMPCA is uploaded by the respective agencies. Further the colleges have to enter other required information and upload the relevant documents for each student admitted under KEA/COMEDK/KRLMPCA/Management/Unfilled sets. The college Principals is informed to make arrangement to enter information of all the students and upload documents correctly.
- The colleges are informed to upload the student document admitted under Management quota, COMEDK, KRLMPCA and unfilled quota at first instance and then the KEA admitted students.
- The college has to ensure that the students who are applying for scholarship are required to create SSPID before submitting the data in admission portal.
- Once the data is submitted and finalized, it cannot be edited.
- After the documents verified by DTE and VTU, the eligible students will get USN from VTU, Belagavi.

7. RESERVATION IN STUDENT ADMISSION POLICY

8.1 INTRODUCTION

The Constitution of India has made provision for making special provision for the advancement of any socially, and educationally backward classes of citizens of or for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Class. In line with this State of Karnataka has enacted THE KARNATAKA PROFESSIONAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION AND DETERMINATION OF FEE) ACT, 2006 which provides reservation of seats to persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes and some other categories in professional educational institutions. All the admission for Government quota of seats is administered by this act.

8.2 OBJECTIVES

- Providing social justice to deprived section of the people.
- Empowering the marginalized sections and ensuring their participation in the decision-making process of the State
- Equal opportunities for differently abled person.

8.3 SCOPE

- This policy shall be applicable to the admissions for Government quota of seats for all the programs offered by RIT.
- Categories covered under this policy are Students belonging to Schedule Cast, Schedule Tribes, OBCs, Students belonging to Rural areas, Students studied in Kannada medium, Students belonging to certain areas like Jammu & Kashmir and Hyderabad Karnataka.
- Special Categories covered under this policy are disabled students, wards of Defense, Ex-defense personnel, Central Armed Police force, Ex- Central Armed Police force; Students participated in NCC, Scouts & Guides, Sports and Students belonging to Anglo-Indian community.

8.4 POLICY

- RIT's Reservation in Students Admission Policy has adopted Section 9 of THE KARNATAKA PROFESSIONAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION AND DETERMINATION OF FEE) ACT, 2006.
- This policy is dynamic i.e, shall be adjusted suitably as and when the Government of
- Karnataka changes or amends the provision the above-mentioned Act.

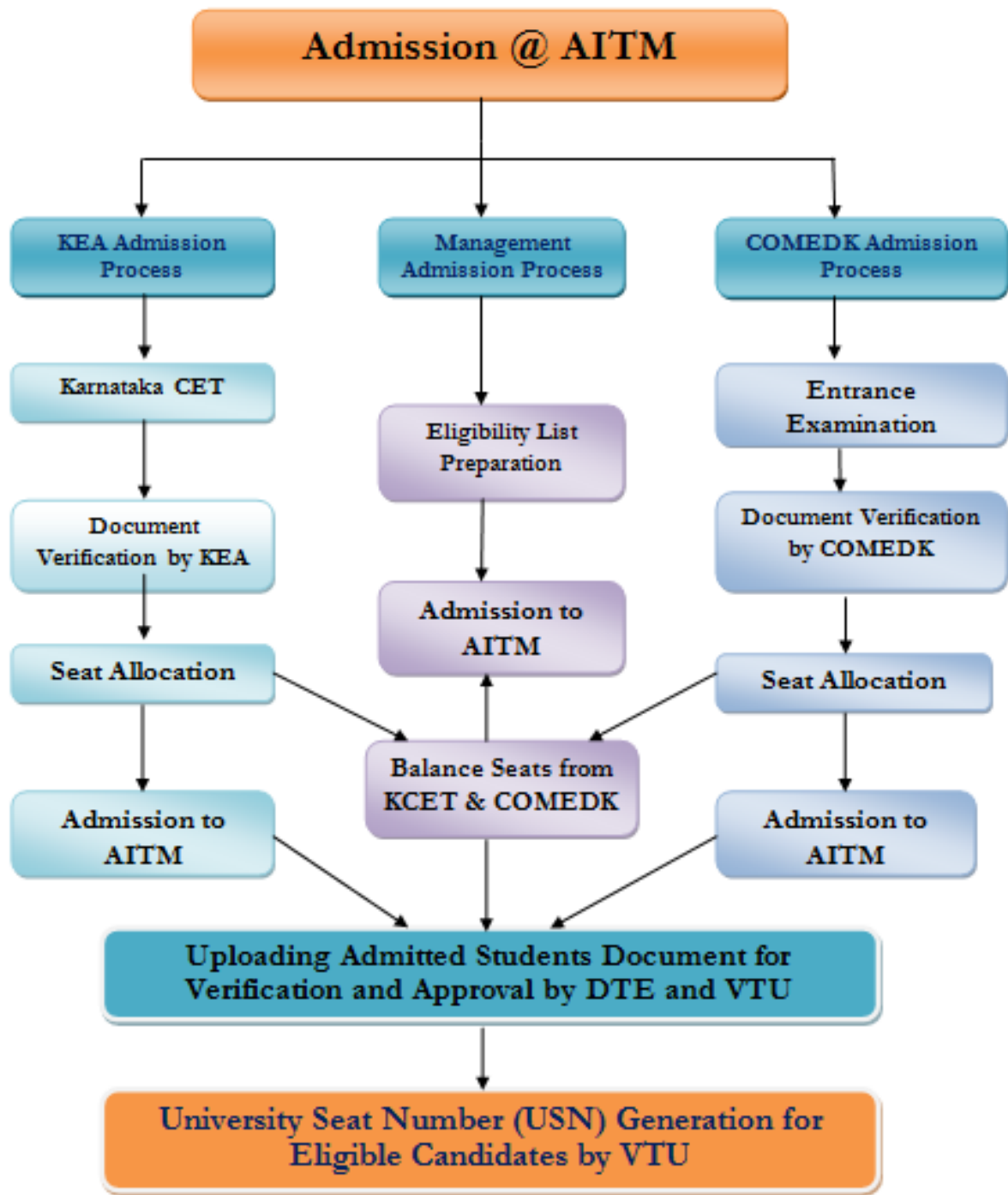
